Over this time, I have frequently been asked by parents and students if there is a book they can purchase which provides multiple questions on topics which are causing difficulty and need to be practised. Sadly, to date, I have been unable to find one. So, I decided to write my own! Many books are available to help teach the skills required to sit the 11 plus. Furthermore, there are many practice books on the market but none, that I have found, which offer more than a few questions on each topic. Due to the requests I have received, I decided a book was needed which offered extensive work on many of the sections commonly tested in the 11 plus. My experience in Verbal Reasoning has been demonstrated by the marks my students consistently achieve in the tests, some have even attained full marks on this paper. I hope my book will help your children to work on the areas they are finding challenging and as the adage states.....practice makes perfect. This book, in MCQ format, is a comprehensive tool that will help Nuclear Medicine and Radiology residents and attending physicians to understand concepts in nuclear medicine.
