This is often at the root of *schadenfreude*. As the author points out, most instances of *schadenfreude* are harmless, on par with the pleasures of light gossip. Yet we must also be mindful that envy can motivate, without full awareness, the engineering of the misfortune we delight in. And envy-induced aggression can take us into dark territory indeed, as Smith shows as he examines the role of envy and *schadenfreude* in the Nazi persecution of the Jews. Filled with engaging examples of *schadenfreude*, from popular reality shows to the Duke-Kentucky basketball rivalry, *The Joy of Pain* provides an intriguing glimpse into a hidden corner of the human psyche.
